Disabling driver signature enforcement

First step in installation is to disable Windows 8 **Driver Signature Enforcement**

Move your mouse cursor to the upper right part on the screen then select following:

Settings ->**Change PC Settings**->choose **General** -> Under “**Advanced Startup**” -> **Restart now**.

Now the system will restart and might take some time to show up the boot menu. Wait for It patiently.

After some time you will be prompted with a menu with following options.

1. Continue
2. Use another operating system
3. Troubleshoot
4. Turn off your PC

Choose **Troubleshoot**

Then the following menu appears.

1. Refresh your PC
2. Reset your PC
3. Advanced Options

Choose **Advanced Options**

Then the following menu appears

System Restore
System Image Recovery
Automatic Repair
Command Prompt
Windows Startup settings
Choose **Windows Startup Settings**, then Click **Restart**.

Now the computer will restart and the boot menu appears. Choose “**Disable Driver Signature Enforcement**” from the menu (press **F7** on keyboard).

Now Windows 8 will start and you can do the installation of the driver that is not digitally signed.
